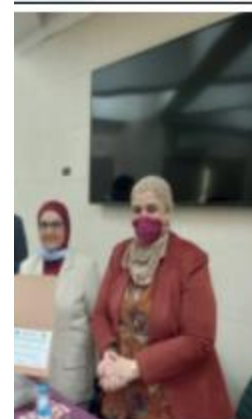

The course was conducted by Dr. Lamis Daoud, Assistant Professor of Medical Biochemistry, Faculty of Medicine - Tanta University. The course was attended by a large number of students and postgraduates interested in the field

of laboratory tests interpretations, and the course yielded excellent results through a survey of trainees.



The clinical nutrition & lifestyle 2020

- Despite the learning difficulties that the country is facing in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Drug and Poison Information Center at the Faculty of Pharmacy at Tanta University has been able to set up a practical training course in the field of clinical nutrition entitled: The clinical nutrition & lifestyle.
- The course was conducted by Dr. Samar Nofal, a lecturer of nutrition in the faculties of pharmacy, a nutritionist and mesotherapy specialist.

- The course included a training workshop on the latest devices and technologies in the field of obesity and nutrition, which enriched the trainees as much as they could go out to the labor market with high skills and confidence in performance. The lectures took place online on the electronic platform of Tanta University and the practical training was conducted inside at the faculty with obeying the safety roles for facing the COVID-19 pandemic.



Student training for the Educational Pharmacy 2020

- To complement the efforts of the Faculty of Pharmacy - Tanta University in serving the scientific and professional community in the pharmaceutical field.
- Two training courses were held over two weeks for students of the Faculty of Pharmacy, Tanta University, from September 19-24, 2020 for the first session, and from September 26 to October 1, 2020 for the second session, with 18 training hours/week/cycle, attended by 10 students in the first session, in addition to 8 Students in the second session due to commitment to all precautionary measures to confront the emerging corona virus.
- The training achieved its practical goals, which included acquiring the trainees the ability to deal with patients inside the pharmacy with full coverage of drug information services, and all other vital career needed skills.
- The training was carried out by members of the Drug and Poison Information Center, in the cooperation of a number of faculty members.



Clinical nutrition training program 2019

- The Drug and Poison Information Center at the Faculty of Pharmacy at Tanta University held a new workshop in the field of clinical nutrition on October 21, 2019 and continued until January 6, 2020 under the title Clinical nutrition training program.
